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## Improvement of vaginal carcinoma with Homeopathy

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Improvement was significant. The patient was relieved of all symptoms and she finally joined service. The improvement was confirmed by the same hospital mentioned above. The case is important in the sense that homeopathic treatment stopped metastasis and further deterioration of symptoms.

A female patient aged 46 came to my clinic on 1<sup>st</sup> November, 2015 for treatment of vaginal carcinoma. The case was diagnosed and treated initially with surgery and chemotherapy at Tata Memorial Hospital. It was a case of squamous cell carcinoma with metastasis. Diagnosis was done by CT scan, positron emission tomography (PET) and biopsy. There was progressive deterioration when the patient first approached me. Vulva removed surgically on 13.03.2012.

**Symptoms:** Swelling of right supra-clavicular lymph nodes. Pulse 76/min, B.P 110/7. Aversion to onion and fish, thirst normal, stool once in the morning, dreams of fire.

**Past history:** Anti-rabid injections for dog-bite, hepatitis B injection, asthma and cancer in family.

**Treatment with homeopathy:** The treatment started from the date of her visit to my clinic till date. During the period the patient was treated occasionally for her ailments other than cancer.

**Medicines given:** *Phosphorus* 0/2, 0/3; *Carcinosin* 0/1, 0/2, 0/3, 0/4, 0/5, 0/6

**Interim treatment:** *Merc sol* 0/1, 0/2, 0/3

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
